DEFINITIONS

Homeschooling

Understood to mean that one or more of the parents/guardians are providing instruction to one or more of their children.

POLICY REGULATIONS

- 1.0 A student receiving home schooling shall be excused from attendance at school, as per the *Education Act* and PPM 131.
- 2.0 Administrative procedures will accompany this policy and will be reviewed regularly to ensure compliance with the *Education Act* and any other related ministry resources, requirements, or expectations.
- 3.0 Principals are responsible for communicating any information relating to home schooling requests with their Superintendent of Education. The Superintendent of Education will ensure that the attendant administrative procedures are implemented accordingly, in partnership with the Principal.
- 4.0 If there are reasonable grounds to suspect that the child is not receiving satisfactory instruction at home, the NCDSB shall conduct an investigation in accordance with the guidelines within PPM 131 and the attendant administrative procedures.

5.0 The NCDSB is not responsible to provide curriculum, program materials or support to parents/guardians who choose to home school their child.
