RESPONSIBILITIES:

Reporting to the Superintendent of Education and working with various and school personnel, the SAT will provide leadership, direction and support to the participants in the Autism-Spectrum Disorder Pilot and participate in the newly created multi-disciplinary team. The SAT will liaise with Resource Teachers, Principals and the other SAT for Special Education in matters relating to special education program delivery, services, intervention strategies and the development of IEPs for both students identified by the IPRC and those who are not using the Ministry Policy Program memorandum and other legislation as the foundation for services. This includes participation in case conferences, IPRCs and other meetings as necessary.

This position is based in the southern part of our Board and will require travel throughout Kirkland Lake, Englehart, New Liskeard and Cobalt, with occasional meetings in Timmins, Sudbury or Toronto.

MANDATORY QUALIFICATIONS:

- Applicants must possess the qualifications in accordance with the Education Act and the pertinent Regulations, including a specialist qualification in Special Education.
- Five (5) years teaching experience.

PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- Excellent communication, interpersonal, and organizational skills;
- Knowledge of programs, services and interventions related to students with Autism-Spectrum Disorder
- Strong community connections and knowledge of community organizations and resources;
- Keen understanding of of the legislation govenrning special education in the province of Ontario and the Ontario curriculum;
- Significant commitment to Catholic education and promotion of the Catholic faith;
- Awareness of Indigenous traditions and pespectives;
