Shrove Tuesday

Pancake Day, or Shrove Tuesday, is the traditional feast day before the start of Lent on Ash Wednesday (tomorrow). Lent – the 40 days leading up to Easter – is a time of fasting and on Shrove Tuesday, Anglo-Saxon Christians went to confession and were "shriven" (absolved from their sins).

Shrove Tuesday was the last opportunity to use up eggs and fats before embarking on the Lenten fast and pancakes are the perfect way of using up these ingredients. Fasting is one way of showing God our desire to be closer to Him. When we give up something we really like and ask God to be nearer to us, He always responds!
