As we begin the new school and pastoral year I'd like to use this first newsletter to update you on some of the fall programs that will be taking place. Throughout this upcoming year we will find ways in our school and parish (and hopefully your home) to celebrate the gift of our Catholic Faith, learn more about it and deepen our personal relationship with Jesus Christ.

UPCOMING SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION PROGRAMS

One of the great gifts that Jesus left to the early Church, and by extension to us, are the sacraments. The sacraments are special gifts, given by Jesus, to help us live holy and

happy lives. They help us draw closer to God and lead more fulfilling and enriching lives as His friends.

Just as there are various stages that we journey through life, so too there are various stages that we journey in our sacramental lives. The school, parish, and home play a special role in the sacramental journey of your child(ren).

BAPTISM is the first of the sacraments of the Church. In and through the Sacrament of Baptism, we are washed clean of original sin, made members of God's Family, and the doorway through which the other sacraments are received.



We will be offering a preparation course for parents who wish to have their child baptized in the Catholic Faith. Preparation consists of three evening sessions spread over a three week period of time.

If you are interested in having your child(ren) baptized, please call the Parish Office (705-268-3053) to register for the next session.

Children who wish to receive the other sacraments of the Catholic Church must be baptized first. As well, in the future if they wish to be a godparent or have their child(ren) one day attend a Catholic school, they must be baptized beforehand.

RECONCILIATION is the privileged means for the followers of Jesus to receive the gift of forgiveness and healing for their sins.

Children in grade three and up are invited to prepare for the Sacrament of Reconciliation in the fall.

Preparation consists of three parent meetings, an in home parent-child workbook, participation in our weekly children's program at Sunday morning Mass, and a retreat afternoon for candidates. The Sacrament of Reconciliation is received during the Advent Season.

All parents who wish to have their child make their First Reconciliation this year must attend an important parent meeting on Thursday, October 1st at 7:00 P.M. in Parish Hall (296 Cedar St. South).

EUCHARIST or communion is the opportunity to receive Jesus, the Bread of Life. Children who have made their First Reconciliation are invited to prepare in the winter months to receive the Body of Christ.



Preparation consists of two parent meetings, an in home parent-child workbook, participation in our weekly children's program at Saturday Evening Mass, and a

retreat afternoon for candidates. The Sacrament of First Eucharist is received during the Easter Season.

All parents who wish to have their child make their First Communion this year must attend an important parent meeting on Thursday, October 1st at 7:00 P.M. in Parish Hall (296 Cedar St. South).

CONFIRMATION is the final Sacrament of Initiation within the Church.

It is celebrated every second year with students in grade seven and eight. Our next program of preparation will begin later this fall with the sacrament being celebrated in spring 2016 with Bishop Poitras.

If you have a child who would like to celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation later this year, please call the Parish Office for further details.
