Criteria	Details

They use their heart and their head at recess</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Invite people to play with you</li><li>• Always share with everyone (toys, balls, etc.)</li><li>• Take turns – everyone gets a turn</li><li>• Care for others</li><li>• Help others, especially if they are hurt</li><li>• Welcome new people</li><li>• Make sure everyone is having fun</li><li>• Make new friends</li><li>• Don't judge</li><li>• Give compliments</li><li>• Comfort each other</li><li>• Include everyone in your games</li><li>• Treat others how you would like to be treated</li></ul>
<b>In order for everyone to have a good recess, St. Pat's students follow rules.</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Listen to supervisors</li><li>• Don't fight with people</li><li>• Don't bring food outside</li><li>• Play on equipment properly (take turns, slide on bum, no jumping off swing)</li><li>• Keep snow, rocks and sand on the ground</li><li>• Stay in your area</li><li>• Line up properly</li><li>• Follow the rules of the game (ex. no handball in soccer)</li><li>• Stop playing when you hear the bell and line up quickly</li><li>• No bullying</li><li>• Keep your hands and feet to yourself (hands off)</li></ul>
