This year, the Ministry of Education has created a new Food and Beverage policy for schools in Ontario. Basically, it puts limits on the amount of times certain foods can be sold at schools. Because of this, we will no longer be having a weekly **HOT DOG lunch**.... Once we figure out how we can adapt to the new procedures, we will send home more information on what type of food-based fundraisers we may run this year.

On this note, I would like to bring to your attention a unique, non food-based fundraiser that we will be undertaking at Holy Family.

We have enrolled in the Terracycle waste reduction program, where our school will collect drink pouches (for example, Kool Aid Jammers), cookie and cracker wrappers, yogurt containers, chocolate bar wrappers and sandwich baggies, and we will receive **2 cents** per item returned!. This money will be put into general student funds and will be used to purchase various items needed at the school.
