## Term # 1 Reports

Please find the enclosed term # 1 report card. This revised report card is designed to show a student's achievement at two points in the school year. The first provincial report card will reflect the student's achievement of curriculum expectations introduced and development from September 4—February 1, as well as the student's development of the learning skills and work habits during that period. The second report card will reflect the student's achievement from February until the end of school in June.

The report card for Grades 1 to 6 provides information for parents about letter grades and levels of achievement, and the provincial report card for Grade 7 and 8 provides information about percentage marks and levels of achievement. Both reports include tear-off sections for the student's comments, the parent's comments and the parent's acknowledgement of receipt of the report card. Friday March 8th.


