SCHOOL WIDE BAPTISM



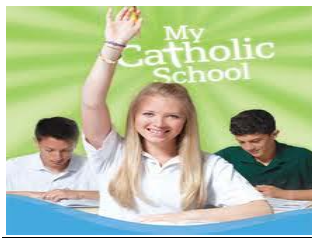
Our school wide baptism is on **Wednesday, April 20 @ 10 am** followed by lunch in the basement of the Church. Please join us as we celebrate our faith!
