PROFESSIONAL ACTIVITY DAY



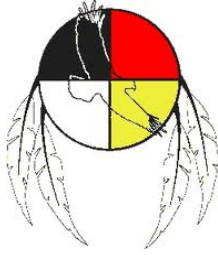
Monday, June 10 is a Professional Activity Day for teachers. There is no school on this day for students. Enjoy your long weekend!
