Everyday Practices for Mental Health and Well-being



Our School is introducing MindUP in classrooms! MindUP is an evidence-based curriculum developed by The Hawn Foundation. MindUP is dedicated to the belief that the child who learns to monitor his or her senses and feelings becomes more aware and better understands how to respond to the world reflectively instead of reflexively. The program is delivered in 4 units over 15 lessons. MindUP is based on 4 core pillars: 1. Neuroscience (learning about the brain), 2. Core Practice (breathing/"brain breaks"), 3. Mindfulness Practices (engaging the 5 senses) and 4. Optimism and Gratitude.

"By learning about how the brain responds to stress and by practising strategies for quieting the mind, students become better at self-regulation, increase their capacity to absorb information and improve their relationship building skills."
