

What is Temperance? Temperance is one of the four cardinal virtues. St. Thomas Aquinas ranked temperance as the fourth of the cardinal virtues, because it serves prudence, justice and fortitude. The moderation of our desires is essential to acting rightly (prudence), giving each one their (justice), and standing strong in the face of adversity (fortitude). Temperance is the virtue which attempts to overcome the human condition that "The spirit is willing, but the flesh is weak" (Mark 14:38)
