VACCINATIONS

The Timiskaming Health Unit nurses will be here Tuesday, April 28th to administer mandatory vaccinations. If your son/daughter has received a consent form, please ensure that it is returned prior to this date.

STUDENT ABSENTEEISM

The attendance verification check is a process which enables schools to verify a student's absence or lateness with the parent or guardian. Parents/guardians are reminded that they must call the school, or leave a message, whenever their child(ren) will be absent or late. Where there are other siblings attending school, a note from the parent is also acceptable. Any students arriving late to school must immediately report to the office upon entering the school. A "late slip" will be issued, and the student must take this slip to his/her teacher. A great deal of learning takes place in the morning as that's when the majority of Language and Math instruction is held, so it is very important that students arrive at school on time. The school grounds are open at 8:30 a.m., at which time there is a supervisor on duty. Most students arrive by bus between 8:30 and 8:50 a.m. Students who walk to school should plan to arrive at approximately the same time.
