We will celebrate Mass, led by Father Henri on Thurs., Feb. 14, at 9:30 am.

Catholic tradition teaches that human dignity can be protected and a healthy community can be achieved only if human rights are protected and responsibilities are met. Corresponding to these rights and duties are responsibilities—to respect one another, our families and the larger society. A virtue is a habit that shows people and God that we are a good person.
