You will also receive Inclement Weather forms, Internet/Use of Information Technology forms as well as School Bus Policy and Procedures pamphlet. PLEASE fill in a form for EACH one of your children and return it to the school as soon as possible. The bus policy form must be completed for all students (including those who do not ride the bus to school) in order to ride the bus for field trips and excursions.
