Bullying and Exclusion

When analysing the survey we could see that the Grade 5 - 6 Girls had the most trouble with bullying and exclusion. The Grade 5 Girls had 40 % and the Grade 6 Girls had 38%. The Grade 6 and Grade 8 Boys had the lowest percentage. The Grade 6 Boys had 13 % and the Grade 8 Boys had 14%. In Grade 6 and Grade 8 the students are having the most problems in Bullying and Exclusion. The mean average for bullying and exclusion is 24%.

Advocacy at School

Overall, in the topic of advocacy at school when analysing the survey it has some bad things and some good things. The Grade 7 Guys have the lowest percentage at 30%. The highest percentage was 64% and it was the Grade 6 Girls. The mean average for advocacy at school is 55%.

Feel Safe Attending this School

This is by far the best in the three categories and I think it is a very good thing, but it would be better if the students weren't feeling like they are getting bullied and excluded as much. The mean average for this is 81%. The lowest percentage was the Grade 5 Girls and the Grade 8 Guys. They both had 60%. The highest was the Grade 7 Guys at 100%. Students at St. Anne School feel safe attending school, but also feel like they are bullied and excluded.
