BUILDING UPGRADES

Application for Funds – Renovations for Kindergarten to Grade 4 School

In July, the senior staff submitted an application for funds to support the renovations needed at the new Kindergarten to Grade 4 school. We have not yet heard back, but will keep our school communities up to date on our progress in this regard. We do hope that we are successful in receiving significant funds to support plans for renovation to the school.

O'Gorman Intermediate Catholic School

The grounds of the school received some much needed care this summer. We are pleased with the new front yard and paving that helped to beautify OICS. Extensive renovations to OICS are not currently needed, in preparation for the consolidation of schools.

SCHOOL NAMING

The Transition Team has agreed that the Grade 5-8 school will remain known as O'Gorman Intermediate Catholic School. In the same way, the school will continue to be identified as the "Junior Knights".

The Kindergarten to Grade 4 school however, will undergo a naming process and will later identify appropriate school colours and an accompanying mascot. It is our hope and intention to build a new school community for staff, students, and their families. We are currently confirming the school-naming process to be followed, but we do expect to unveil the new school name at the December 9th Inaugural Board Meeting. More details on this exciting process to come shortly!
