Connecting Faith to Daily Life

During Lent, we are called to renew our relationship with God and with others through the traditional Lenten practices of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving.

- Prayer: Deepen your connection to God through quiet reflection, journaling, or community prayer services.
- Fasting: Simplify your days – give up habits that distract from what matters most, or fast from negativity, gossip, or waste.
- Almsgiving: Share what you have with others – through kindness, time, or service to those in need.

When we walk together in faith, we bring the message of Lent – forgiveness, compassion, and renewal – to life.

Ideas to Live Out our Theme

Lenten Path of Renewal

Create a visual pathway or bulletin board where students add footprints or hearts showing acts of kindness, prayer, or forgiveness as the weeks progress.

Forgiveness Stones

Invite students or staff to decorate small stones as symbols of letting go – of anger, hurt, or worry – and choosing peace instead.

Walk Together Project

Plan a school or class walk focused on prayer and reflection, symbolizing the Lenten journey toward Easter.

Reconciliation Tree

Hang written prayers for healing, peace, or forgiveness on a tree in the school foyer or chapel as a sign of community renewal.

Stations of the Cross

Invite students to lead creative reflections on each station – through art, poetry, or drama – highlighting themes of courage, compassion, and love.
